TCC PARTNERS WITH ILRI IN FACILITATING COURSE IN SCIENTIFIC WRITING AND PUBLISHING

TCC held two short courses on Scientific Writing and Publishing on 25-26 November and 2-3 December 2014 at the International Livestock Research Institute, Nairobi Campus, Kenya.

The course was organized by the Training Centre in Communication (TCC) Nairobi and the International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI) . The entire course was facilitated by the TCC local team, namely, Mr John Kamanu an agronomist and a Land Resource Management PhD candidate at the Land Resource Management and Agricultural Technology at the University of Nairobi .
